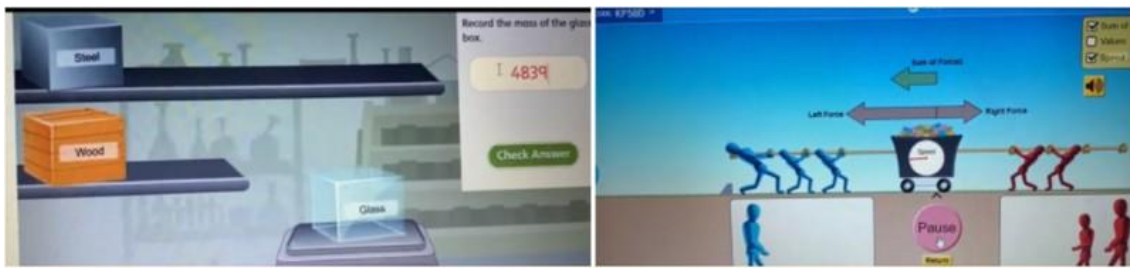
Dear parents,

Within the inquiry process, students investigate scientific behaviors such as observing, recording, and developing hypotheses, viewing, and conducting the experiments.

Human societies interact with the natural world with materials, design, and stability

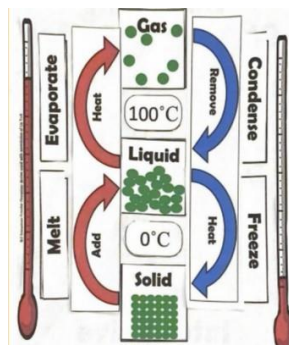
Lines of Inquiry:
