


Sight Words Activities

Activity1: Tic-Tac-Toe

Children will play a game of traditional

Tic-Tac-Toe, with the added the sight words (they-go-with-my-little-was) and they must read it correctly before they place an X or O on the game board. The goal of Tic-Tac-Toe is to encourage your child to read sight words quickly. You can play this game with your child, or two children can play each other.





Activity2: Post-It Memory Game

1. Write out the sight words (they-go-with-my-little-was) onto

a white board or just use a sheet of paper.

2. Write out the matching words onto individual post-it notes use different colors to make the game more visually appealing for the child.

3. Sit down with your child and encourage POST-IT MEMORY GAME them to choose a post-it note, call out the word then match it up to the corresponding word on the whiteboard or sheet of paper.

Reading and Writing CVC Words



Objectives:

- Differentiate sounds.
- Know that words are made up of sounds that put together.
- Know the differences between vowels and consonants.
- Hear the differences in words that sound alike such as (hug, bug), (fun, gun), and (but, nut).







CVC Words Activities

Activity1: Muffin Tin Spelling

Give the kids magnet letters (if you don't have the magnet letters you can use any kind or You can write the letters on small pieces of papers).

Show the kids different pictures of CVC words or just say the name (e.g. cup - cat - mug - bat) and ask them to spell it and write it using the letters by putting them on the muffin tray.

If you want make it more challenging you can set the time 20-30 seconds for each word.






Blending Online Game:
